

NOTICE OF THE DRAFT CONCENTRATED ANIMAL FEEDING OPERATION
GENERAL PERMIT AUTHORIZATION NO. OKG010022

Pursuant to the Oklahoma Agriculture Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (AgPDES) Act and Oklahoma AgPDES Rules (OAC 35:44), notice is hereby given that the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry (ODAFF), at the address listed below, has processed and issued a draft permit authorization including permit terms to Frank Berry & Sons, Inc., Route 1, Box 108, Texhoma, OK 73949, based on the notice of intent (NOI) submitted on June 7, 2023, for coverage under the Agricultural Pollutant Discharge Elimination System General Permit OKG010000 for Discharges from Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations (CAFOs). No discharge of pollutants into the waters of the state is authorized by this general permit except under a 25-year, 24-hour precipitation event or greater. All waste and/or wastewater will be beneficially used on agricultural land and/or transferred off site for beneficial reuse. Berry & Sons Feedyard operates a 2,000 head cattle CAFO facility under the Standard Industrial Classification Code 0211. The Berry & Sons Feedyard facility is located in the N/2 Section 35, Township 1 North, Range 11 East C.M., Texas County, Oklahoma. The facility is located in the North Canadian (Beaver) River watershed (Waterbody ID No. OK720510000090_00) of the Panhandle Region Basin. The designated beneficial uses of the potential receiving water(s) are public and private water supplies, fish and wildlife propagation/warm water aquatic community, agriculture, primary body contact recreation, aesthetics, and fish consumption.

Comments should include: (1) name and address of the interested person, (2) the CAFO name to which the comment relates, and (3) a narrative comment and description of how the related authorization may affect quality of the waters of the State.
