SUMMARY:

The proposed amendments provides clean up language, establishes electronic registrations for fertilizers and soil amendment products. Designates a method for Scrap Metal Dealers to track transactions, comply with record requirements for purchase of vehicles, and provides a penalty for late renewals.
